## SUBJECT: EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT – RIVANNA PUMP STATION

## **DATE: JANUARY 16, 2024**

This memorandum serves as official notice of Emergency Procurement as required by the Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority procurement manual and Section 2.2-4303 of the Virginia Public Procurement Act.

On January 9, 2024, Bill Mawyer, the RWSA Executive Director, at the request of staff, provided an emergency declaration concerning the flooding, response and rehabilitation of the Rivanna Pump Station located at the Moores Creek Advanced Water Resource Recovery Facility (MCAWRRF). Upon investigation, it has been determined that a significant precipitation event occurred causing flooding in the Rivanna River basin and ancillary flow into the pump station. The high flow event caused catastrophic damage to the pump station. The damage has necessitated extensive bypass pumping and will require timely mechanical and electrical rehabilitation. Due to the urgency and scope of the multi-phase work effort, outside vendor and contractor assistance is required.

To date we have procured the following firms to assist with this emergency effort:

- Faulconer Construction Company existing term contract for excavation and bypass pumping installation
- Digs, Inc. existing term contract for bypass pumping installation
- Blue Fox existing term contract for assistance with bypass pumping installation
- Xylem/Godwin emergency procurement for bypass pumping equipment rental and fabrication
- MEB Construction emergency procurement for investigation and rehabilitation
- Hazen and Sawyer Engineers existing term contract for engineering support services
- Commercial Steel Erection, Inc. emergency
